

I note many people talk about what happened to make them saved, but few examine or refer to what the Bible says one must do or have to be saved. I did a quick study, and put together the list below.

If we are all saved in a “like manner” (meaning, we all are saved the same way Acts 15:11) and the Bible says that there are things we must do to be saved, then which of this can be excluded to be saved?

Per the Bible:

You are saved by endurance to the end - Matthew 10:22

You are saved by hearing God's word – Hebrews 11:6

You are saved by belief/faith - Mark 16:16, John 3:16, Romans 10:9, Acts 16:31

You are saved by knowledge of God – II Peter 1:2-3

You are saved by repentance – Acts 2:38, 2 Corinthians 7:10

You are saved by calling on the name of the Lord – Acts 2:21, Romans 10:13

You are saved by confessing Jesus Christ as Lord – Romans 10:9, Acts 8:37

You are saved by baptism – Mark 16:16, Acts 2:38, I Peter 3:21

You are saved by obedience – I Peter 1:22, 4:17

You are saved by works – Philippians 2:12, I John 2:29

I think I will “Part II” this question to ask what it was that saved you apart from your action, so if you note that Grace, Love, etc of God are missing, I think I want that to be a different question (since that is what God did for our salvation)

My purpose here is to see if, after looking at the list above, you consider if you are one who may have only a form of Godliness, but not unto salvation; or, if you understand that these things are “written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life” I John 5:13?
